Both exhibitions are open 10:00am to 04:00pm on Saturday & Sunday.

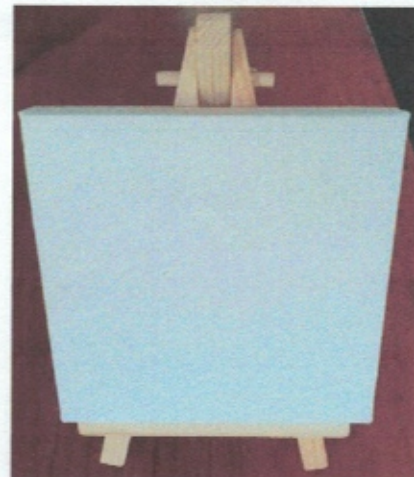
Attendants are required at each venue – if you have an hour or two to assist that would be great.

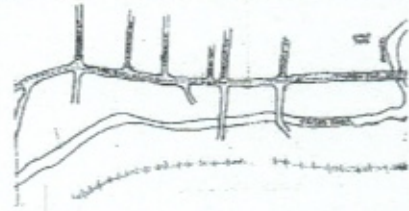
